

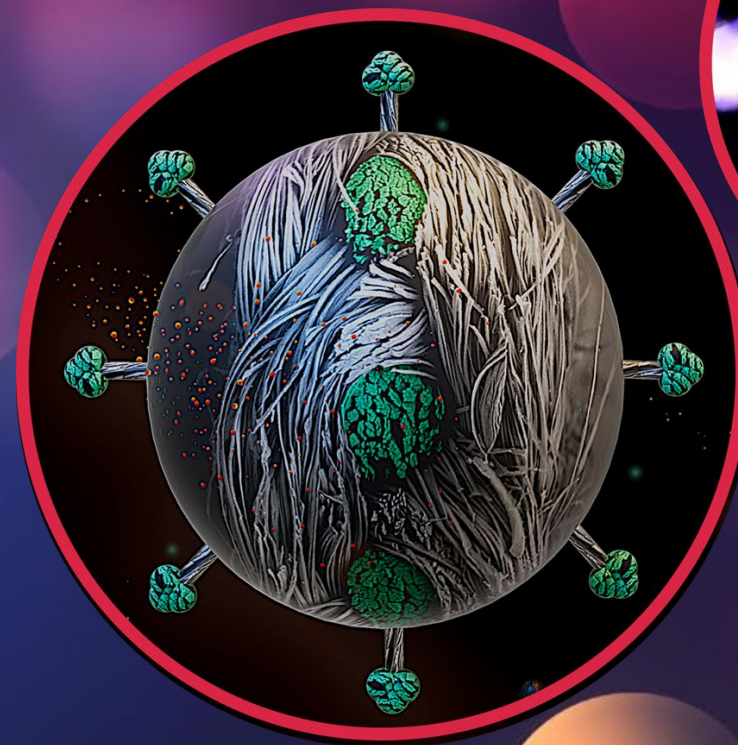
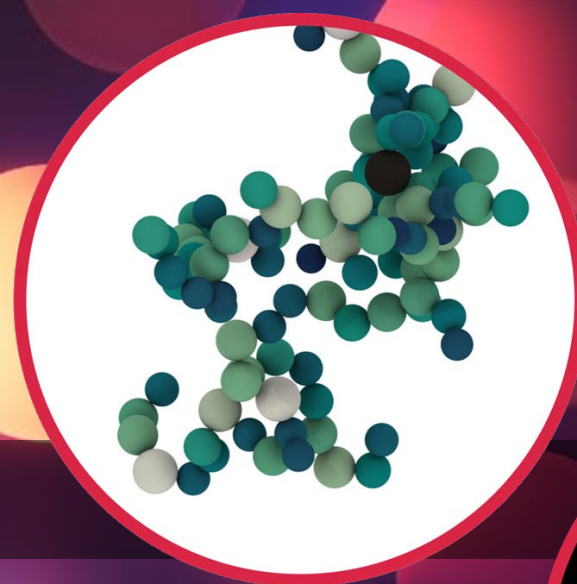

# 2022 Recipient of the Susanne V. Hering Award



Lidia Morawska

Lidia Morawska is a Distinguished Professor in the School of Earth and Atmospheric Sciences, at the Queensland University of Technology (QUT) in Brisbane, Australia.

“Dr. Morawska is a leading international scientist who has significantly pushed the boundaries of the science of air pollution and influenced the way society operates to mitigate air pollution risks.”

“Two of her major achievements are: (1) influencing the public health management of the transmission of respiratory infections and (2) developing international recommendations for ultrafine particles through the World Health Organization (WHO).”

“Her work during the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic on airborne transmission of infectious agents warrants special attention.”

“Her publication record is impressive not only in quantity (more than 400 listed publications with almost 90,000 citations in the Web of Science by 31.03.2022), but more importantly in quality (current H-Index: 95). She publishes in the highest-ranked scientific journals. This includes The Lancet, Nature and Science. Many of her publications have been recognized as “key papers.”
